HOLY CROSS CATHOLIC CHURCH

Holy Cross Church began in 1884 as a mission. Visiting priests from the parish in Lockeford held services for Catholics in the Linden area. In 1915, a church was built on the present parish property. The congregation out grew the old church, and that wood frame building was moved to the rear of the property to make way for a new church. The present stucco church was built in 1953, and was dedicated on April 4, 1954. It was constructed by Stockton builders, Ben Merlo and Dan Nomellini. The beautiful cathedral style stained glass windows were created by Carl Huneke, Century Stained Glass Studio, San Francisco. The windows were installed in 1954 shortly after the completion of the church. Members of the congregation donated those windows. In 1963, Holy Cross was made a Parish of the Diocese of Stockton by Bishop Hugh A. Donohoe. The rectory, designed by architect Edward C. Merlo was added in 1975. The activities center and classrooms were completed in 1996.

The Story of Father’s Day

Father’s Day, contrary to popular misconception, was not established as a holiday in order to help greeting card manufacturers sell more cards. In fact, when a “father’s day” was first proposed, there were no Father’s Day cards!



Ms. John B. Dodd, of Washington, first proposed the idea of a “father’s day” in 1909. Dodd wanted a special day to honor her father, William Smart. Smart, a Civil War veteran, was widowed when his wife died in childbirth with their sixth child. Smart was left to raise the newborn and his other five children by himself on a rural farm in eastern Washington state. It was after Dodd became an adult that she realized the strength and selflessness her father had shown in raising his children as a single parent.

The first Father’s Day was observed on June 19, 1910, in Spokane, Washington. At about the same time in various towns and cities across America, other people were beginning to celebrate “Father’s Day.” In 1924, President Calvin Coolidge supported the idea of a national Father’s Day. Finally, in 1966, President Lyndon Johnson signed a presidential proclamation declaring the third Sunday of June as Father’s Day.

El Día del Padre, contrario al concepto erróneo popular, no fue establecido como un día festivo para ayudar a los fabricantes de tarjetas a vender más. En realidad, cuando "el día del Padre" fue propuesto por primera vez, ¡no había tarjetas del Día del Padre!

La esposa de John B. Dodd, de Washington, propuso la idea de un "Día del Padre" en 1909. La Sra. Dodd quería un día especial para honrar a su padre, William Smart. Smart, un veterano de la Guerra Civil, quedó viudo cuando su esposa murió al dar a luz a su sexto hijo. Smart quedó solo criando a su recién nacido y a sus cinco hijos en un rancho rural al este del estado de Washington. Fue después de que la Sra. Dodd se convirtió en una adulta que se dio cuenta de la fuerza y desprendimiento que su padre había mostrado al criar a sus hijos como un padre soltero.

El primer Día del Padre fue celebrado el 19 de Junio de 1910, en Spokane, Washington. Al mismo tiempo en varios pueblos y ciudades a través de America, más gente empezó a celebrar "El Día del Padre." En 1924, el Presidente Calvin Coolidge apoyó la idea de un día del Padre nacional. Finalmente en 1966 el Presidente Lyndon Johnson firmó una proclamación presidencial declarando el tercer Domingo de junio como Día del Padre.

El Día del Padre ha sido un día no solo para honrar a los padres, pero también a todos los hombres que actúan como figuras paternas. Padrastros, tíos, abuelos, y hombres adultos amigos son todos honrados el Día del Padre. El Día de la Madre llegó primero, pero el Día del Padre no estaba muy lejos de llegar.
