HOLY CROSS CATHOLIC CHURCH

Holy Cross Church began in 1884 as a mission. Visiting priests from the parish in Lockeford held services for Catholics in the Linden area. In 1915, a church was built on the present parish property. The congregation out grew the old church, and that wood frame building was moved to the rear of the property to make way for a new church. The present stucco church was built in 1953, and was dedicated on April 4, 1954. It was constructed by Stockton builders, Ben Merlo and Dan Nomellini. The beautiful cathedral style stained glass windows were created by Carl Huneke, Century Stained Glass Studio, San Francisco. The windows were installed in 1954 shortly after the completion of the church. Members of the congregation donated those windows. In 1963, Holy Cross was made a Parish of the Diocese of Stockton by Bishop Hugh A. Donohoe. The rectory, designed by architect Edward C. Merlo was added in 1975. The activities center and classrooms were completed in 1996.

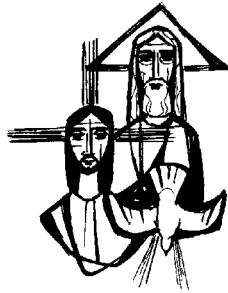

LA PRUEBA DE LA DOCTRINA EN LAS ESCRITURAS

La evidencia del Evangelio culmina en la tarea bautismal de Mateo 28:20. Se manifiesta por las narraciones de los Evangelistas que Cristo dijo la gran verdad solo a los Doce, paso por paso. Primero les enseñó a reconocer en El el Eterno Hijo de Dios. Cuando su Ministerio estaba a punto de terminar, El les prometió que el Padre les mandaría otra Persona Divina, al Espíritu Santo, en Su lugar. Finalmente después de su Resurrección, El reveló su doctrina en términos muy específicos ordenándonos “vayan y enseñen a todas las naciones, bautícenlos en el nombre del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo.” (Mateo 28:18). La fuerza de éste pasaje es decisivo. Que “el Padre” y “el Hijo” son distintas personas surgió de su propio término, que son con exclusión recíproca. La mención del Espíritu Santo en la misma serie, los nombres que han sido conectados unos con otros por las conjunciones “y...y” es evidencia que tenemos aquí una tercera Persona conectada con el Padre y el Hijo, y todo esto excluye la suposición de que los Apóstoles entendieron que el Espíritu Santo no es una distinta Persona, sino lo que Dios vio de sus acciones en las criaturas.

The Most Holy Trinity PROOF OF DOCTRINE FROM SCRIPTURE

The evidence from the Gospels culminates in the baptismal commission of Matthew 28:20. It is manifest from the narratives of the Evangelists that Christ only made the great truth known to the Twelve step by step. First He taught them to recognize in Himself the Eternal Son of God.

When His ministry was drawing to a close, He promised that the Father would send another Divine Person, the Holy Spirit, in His place. Finally after His resurrection, He revealed the doctrine in explicit terms, bidding them "go and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost" (Matthew 28:18). The force of this passage is decisive. That "the Father" and "the Son" are distinct Persons follows from the terms themselves, which are mutually exclusive. The mention of the Holy Spirit in the same series, the names being connected one with the other by the conjunctions "and . . . and" is evidence that we have here a Third Person co-ordinate with the Father and the Son, and excludes altogether the supposition that the Apostles understood the Holy Spirit not as a distinct Person, but as God viewed in His action on creatures.
