HOLY CROSS CATHOLIC CHURCH

Holy Cross Church began in 1884 as a mission. Visiting priests from the parish in Lockeford held services for Catholics in the Linden area. In 1915, a church was built on the present parish property. The congregation out grew the old church, and that wood frame building was moved to the rear of the property to make way for a new church. The present stucco church was built in 1953, and was dedicated on April 4, 1954. It was constructed by Stockton builders, Ben Merlo and Dan Nomellini. The beautiful cathedral style stained glass windows were created by Carl Huneke, Century Stained Glass Studio, San Francisco. The windows were installed in 1954 shortly after the completion of the church. Members of the congregation donated those windows. In 1963, Holy Cross was made a Parish of the Diocese of Stockton by Bishop Hugh A. Donohoe. The rectory, designed by architect Edward C. Merlo was added in 1975. The activities center and classrooms were completed in 1996.

WINTER - ORDINARY TIME (The Meaning)

Christian Life is anchored in the Paschal Mystery. The death, Resurrection, and Ascension of Jesus always remain at the center of our identity, as the celebration of the Eucharist this time focuses on the death of Christ. Nevertheless, the liturgical year celebrates "the whole mystery of Christ." The public mystery of Jesus-his life and teaching, his miracles, the message he preached, his interactions with his disciples, his travels, the encounters he had with all kinds of people, the conflicts and divisions that his presence unmasked teaches us invaluable truths about who he is. It is this public ministry that we turn to in *Ordinary Time*.

By walking with Jesus through the weeks of *Ordinary Time*, the Christian people also discover anew what it means to be disciples of the Lord. We set out on a journey of faith. We have heard the Gospel stories before, yet each year holds something new for us. This is the keynote for the weeks ahead. We have celebrated the birth of Christ. Now we are asked to "come and see" where he lives and what he is all about. Rediscover the exhilarating call of Jesus, wrestle with his teachings, and exult in the liberating power of the *Good News*.

TIEMPO ORDINARIO - INVIERNO (El significado)

La vida Cristiana esta ligada al Misterio Pascual. La Muerte, Resurrección y Ascención de Jesús siempre esta en el centro de nuestra identidad, en este tiempo la celebración de la Eucaristía se enfoca en la muerte de Cristo. Aunque el año litúrgico celebra "el misterio entero de Cristo."
